Volunteers will be placed in positions that match their interests and capabilities. Hours are flexible and mutually arranged by a staff member from the Recreation Department.

After all hours have been completed, it is the responsibility of the volunteer to turn in his/her completed Community Service time sheet to the Recreation Department immediately.
