Downtown Pump Station Improvement – Proposal from Arcadis: Arcadis representative Said AbouAbbdalah gave an overview of the pumpstation improvements recommended and discussed with the committee on the costs associated with the improvements. Weir to get with the Fiscal Officer to discuss possibilities for funding the improvements. Will get proposal from Arcadis to provide the first step towards the improvement with an analysis of what actually needs to be done at the pumpstation that will include more detail and accurate costs.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Adjustment Journal November/December: Mr. Hornung made a motion to approve the Adjustment Journal as presented, seconded by Mr. Morrow. All in favor: Yeas (3).
- Clean Up After Your Dog Signs West End of Royal Oak at Turn Around:
 Last property owner on Royal Oak is requesting that the village install signs requiring people to clean up after their dogs if they walk in the cul-de-sac.
 Committee requested that Mr. Ehrhart install the same type of sign with bags that is currently at the Splash Park on the northwest side of the cul-de-sac near the entrance of the cul-de-sac.
- 3. **Ponding/Freezing Water Manuel Lopez Home:** Mr. Hornung explained that water is ponding in the street in front of the Manuel Lopez Home in Woodsong Development and requested the Mr. Ehrhart take a look to see if the problem can be fixed. Mr. Ehrhart will take a look. Mr. Hornung also asked Mr. Ehrhart to take a look at a catchbasin on Timberidge that is sinking.
