

**VILLAGE OF MIDDLEFIELD'S
STREETS, SIDEWALKS & UTILITIES MEETING
JUNE 2, 2016**

The Village of Middlefield's Streets, Sidewalks and Utilities Committee was called to order at 12:00 noon by Chairman Mr. Hornung with the following members present: Mr. Carl Hornung and Mr. Sam Morrow. Mayor Garlich excused.

Also present: Mr. Dan Weir – Administrator, Charlie Ehrhart-Director of Streets & Utilities, Ms. Leslie McCoy-Econ Dir./Zoning Insp. and Police Chief Tucholski.

Agenda: No additions or deletions.

Minutes of June 2, 2016 were presented for approval. ***Mr. Morrow moved to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Mr. Hornung. All in favor: Yeas (2)***

1. **Adjustment Journal – June:** There were no adjustment for June.
2. **Water Meters:** The land owner is responsible to pay for a second meter should they need one. It is also their responsibility to have the meter correctly installed. A meter cost \$150.00.
3. **Cost for Additional Lawn Meter:** Discussed under water meters.
4. **Stewart Property:** Ms. McCoy sent a second letter regarding property issues. Chief Tucholski stated that Mr. Stewart will be coming from Florida to remove the vehicles.
5. **Additional Handicap Parking at Splash Park:** Mr. Hornung questioned whether there is additional room to place more spots. Mr. Ehrhart gave a couple recommendations as a way to add an additional 2 spots. There are currently 3 spots available. The committee will discuss this further at additional meetings.
6. **Trash at Recycle Center 6-28-16 – Discussion:** Mr. Ehrhart stated that the recycling is picked up on Monday and Thursday. People are leaving objects that are not allowed. There was furniture dumped at the site. The site is open to anyone. The dumpsters are at no cost to the village; grant through Geauga-Trumbull Solid Waste District. Discussed possibly limiting the hours that the site is open. GTSWD has offered to add more dumpsters. Discussed possibly installing a surveillance camera. Discussed looking at curbside pickup for the village residents. Mr. Weir is discussing moving the dumpster out to the township. The village is not the only site having issues, other sites in the county deal with the same issues. Discussed possibly having more frequent pickups or move the pickup day from Thursday to Friday. The committee really doesn't want to discontinue the program but something has to be done. Discussed installing a driveway off of Almeda and closing the driveway from Thompson. Mr. Weir will contact GTSWD to see if possible for township to have a site in addition to the village site.
