1. Police Department - General Discussion on Department Issues: Chief Tucholski gave the statistics for the month of June. Calls are running parallel to last years. The department is working the case against Dr. Becker along with the prosecutor's office. There have been some larger thefts at Walmart from out of town people. Will increase security and police presence in town for the RNC. Have been reviewing protest policies for the village. Some business have contracted with the police department for extra security. The officers on patrol have noticed more out of state plates than normal.
