- 1. **Personnel:** Officer Boxler has been training with Officer Suschek. Boxler is taking the lead on all calls at this time and will be transitioning to Officer Naudad next week and then will finish up with Sgt. Nevison. During training the officer is graded every day and documented. Ms. Jones is progressing in her training. Still looking for a part-time officer.
- 2. **Training**: Chief Tucholski stated that Lt. Savage and Officer Dawson attended a 5 days school through OTOA on SWAT Training. Discussion regarding when this training would or could be used. Officer Suschek went to an NRA Firearms training school. Officer Gray attended a Juvenile diversion course. Officer Aveni went to a Drug Enforcement Course. Subject Control Training for all officers; Chief Tucholski gave an overview of what was involved in this course.
- Statistics: Chief Tucholski gave the statistics for the month of July. There were 397 calls for service. About 150 calls less than this same time frame last year. No bike patrol and no foot patrol. July had a lot of training and bike and foot patrol will start again in August.
- 4. **Crimes**: Chief Tucholski went over some of the various crimes that the department has been investigating. Several thefts, drugs and suicide attempts.
