NEW BUSINESS

1. **Ordinance 14-138 Authorizing the hiring of David Detweiler as a Part-Time Program Supervisor for the Recreation Department, Ratifying the Hiring of Detweiler on August 15, 2014 and Declaring an Emergency:** Ms. Warren did a phone pole and all of council agreed to the hiring of Mr. Detweiler. *Mayor Garlich made a motion to recommend Ordinance 14-138 to Council, seconded by Mr. Hofstetter. All in favor: Yeas (2)*
2. **Amish Buggy Classic:** Ms. Warren stated that the race was held on July 26th, had 58 entrants that participated in the run. Hired HMA Promotions to help with set up, timing and results. Discussed advertisement options. Discussed possible changes for next year; donating profits to a charity.
3. **Middlefield's Got Talent Too:** The event had 13 performers. The top three performed at Summer Fest.
4. **Soccer:** Practices start next week, there are four teams. The program is down one team due to the Middle school having a team this year.
5. **Football & Cheerleading:** The first game is schedule for September 11th. The teams will be announced at the September 5th. Ms. Warren has information regarding the MRSA that has been found at the schools. Will be sanitizing the youth programs equipment before practices. There are three confirmed cases of MRSA at the schools.
6. **Volleyball:** Currently taking registration; practices will start the second week of September with games starting in October.
7. **General Discussion:** Huskie Nation will be attending the Council meeting. Need to get back to Ms. Collier regarding her inquiring about a pool in the Village. Mr. Hofstetter stated that he received a request for a toddler pad at the splash park.
