Here are some places where you might find mosquito larvae in your yard. You may want to save this list so you can check your yard once a week - especially during the summer months.

	you thrown away or covered any old tires in your yard? (For tire swings or round equipment, drill a hole in the bottom to drain the water.)
Are th	here any toys left out in the yard that hold water?
Check	tree-holes for water. If water is found, fill or treat the tree-hole.
-	ditches clean of weeds, trash and lawn clippings to prevent mosquito ing sites.
Savin	g rainwater for plants? Cover the bucket with a piece of window screen.
Flush	out your birdbath once a week to prevent mosquito breeding.
•	in cans, plastic cups, bottles, or debris in your yard? Throw them out before become mosquito homes.
	r pet's water bowl outside? Clean it and add fresh water every day. uitoes can transmit dog heartworm, too!
Empt	y swimming pool tarps, boat tarps, etc.
Clean	roof gutters. Empty tarps that hold water.
Empt	y wading pools daily.
