To be appointed to the department, an applicant must meet the following minimum qualifications:

- be a citizen of the United States;
- be a high school graduate or equivalent;
- be at least twenty-one (21) years of age
- have the ability to obtain, and must have obtained, a valid state of Ohio Driver's license within the time prescribed by state of Ohio law;
- be able to read and write the English language;
- Not have been discharged from the United States Military under less than honorable conditions;
- be of good moral character;
- be able to legally possess and carry a firearm;
- Satisfactorily passes a background check;
- Satisfactorily passes an employment history check;
- Pass a drug screen;
- Satisfactorily completes a psychological examination;
- Possess a current State of Ohio Peace Officer Commission Certification Identification Number
- Satisfactorily complete a voice stress analysis or polygraph examination and

Further, a person will not be appointed, reappointed, or reinstated if he/she has a felony or domestic violence conviction on their record.
