The Village of Middlefield Public Safety Committee Minutes May 10, 2018

The Village of Middlefield's Public Safety Meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Ron Wiech, Mr. Bill Blue and Mr. Carl Hornung.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Personnel: Officer Boxler has been in his own car for a while. Officer Spitler will be transitioning to his own vehicle and Officer Spitler will be moved to nights and Boxler will come to days and the Lt. will be 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. Still taking applications for the part-time positions. Discussion regarding the SRO (School Resource Officer). Still waiting on the School Board for funding and the SRO in the school is Step 5 of the 5 Step plan. Further discussion regarding the safety updates to the schools.
- 2. **Training**: Officer Dawson completed training on subject control and is a trainer now. Det. Suschak and Sgt. Nevison completed A.L.I.C.E. training at the schools also worked with the Nursing homes and their staff. Still doing active shooter training and range qualifying.
- 3. Statistics: Chief Tucholski gave the statistics for the month of April. 367 calls for service for the month and 1,384 for the year. Still working on the stolen car from Woodsong. There are several different agencies working this case simultaneously. There are 3 active Sexting cases currently being investigated; there are very long drawn out cases. Typically there are about 100 man hours involved in these cases.
- 4. **Crimes**: About 10% of traffic stops produce drugs found in a vehicle or paraphernalia. Typically find meth and marijuana. The SO made more arrests involving drugs at the Dollar General and OTG this week.
- 5. General Discussion: Discussion regarding equipment and things that need to be updated and also the grants that have been applied for to help pay for the expensive equipment. The dash cams are obsolete and the companies does not make parts for them anymore. They were installed in about 2004. The sedan will need to be replaced next year. Discussion regarding riot gear and ammo supplies. Discussion regarding the new cameras at Eagle Park and various other locations around town.
