Traffic stops are down due to the officers being too busy with reports and investigations. There have been an influx of cases from the school and these cases take 100's of man hours. There has been an increase in the thefts at Walmart which includes an increase in man hours.
- 4. **Crimes**: There were two DOA's in the last month. One of the people was almost an indigent burial. Discussion regarding interning indigent burial in the Columbarium.
- 5. General Discussion: Looking to buy some new in car cameras. Received a grant from Walmart and a donation from the VFW to go towards the purchase of these cameras. The sedan was due to be replaced this year but due to budget restraints the department will run the car for another year.
