- Personnel: Chief Tucholski stated that there are no issues with the Officers. The
  department has had a couple of guys apply and are close to completing all ride
  along with all the current officers and will be moving along to the background
  checks.

   Officers Suschak and Gray attended EBOC, the high speed pursuit training and

   the initial hiring.

- 4. Crimes: Stopped a vehicle for speed. The officer smelled marijuana. Suspects gave permission to search, had Marijuana, LSD, Cocaine and Drug paraphernalia. Discussion regarding an OVI and Assault case. Had a male and female who overdosed on Pierce Street. The male received 2 doses of narcan and the female received 3 doses of narcan. Both parties survived; they were not charged due to the "Good Samaritan Law". Chief Tucholski gave a brief explanation of the "Good Samaritan Law". UH will be donating more narcan to the department. There were 4 pink slips issued. Discussion held regarding the pink slips for the month. Theft of liquor at Giant Eagle. There was a death of a man and he was found in the port-a-potty behind Johnson Rubber; the coroner was called.
- 5. **General Discussion:** Discussion regarding the use of Golf Carts in the Village. Mayor Garlich stated that the State of Ohio has all kinds of requirements.
