

Village of Middlefield Recreation Committee Minutes
April 11, 2019

Also plans on having some of the players attend lunches with the younger kids to try and boost participation. The programs that are with the park district is Pond dipping on June 2nd and a scavenger hunt along the Maple Highland Trail on July 29. The next paint and sip will be held on May 19th and will be a wooden sign with a frosted mason jar attached. Egg Hunt Tickets are currently on sale. Ms. Warren stated that she will be attending the Middlefield Library Volunteer Fair this Saturday.
