

**The Village of Middlefield

2. **Training:** Officer Boxler attended Advanced Road Side Interview Techniques. Officer Naudad went to Counter Ambush Techniques. The department is qualifying for range this month. Lt. Savage gave a brief description of the multi department training that was held at the old Tractor Supply building over the weekend. Will be doing more training at the school this summer and will be doing traffic stop simulation. The committee complimented the Fire Department how well trained that they are and the knowledge that the department has. The Village is very lucky to have them.
3. **Statistics:** Chief Tucholski gave the statistics for the month of April. There were 394 calls for service. Calls are down for the year compared to last year's totals. 933 business checks for the month of April. 69 hours in the school in April. The hours would have been higher except the schools canceled the metal detectors.
4. **Crimes:** Lt. Savage stated that Kraftmaid had an unconscious male. Medcor was first on scene and did CPR was not breathing and turning blue. Office Naudad took over CPR and when the male was transported he was breathing. There was an overdose at the apartments; still under investigation.
5. **Equipment/Vehicles:** Chief Tucholski stated that the plate readers will be installed within the month. Discussion regarding the bullet proof vest and the shelf life of the equipment. Sgt. Nevison stays on top of this and the vest has been ordered and the grants have been applied for.
