

**The Village of Middlefield
Public Safety Committee Minutes
August 8, 2019**

5. **Equipment/Vehicles:** Chief Tucholski stated that the vehicles are in good shape and no equipment needed. There are no vehicles expected in 2020.
6. **General Discussion:** Discussion regarding a stray dog, a german shepard looking dog, that the department has been trying to catch. Has been sighted in Woodsong and now Northview Drive. Chief Tucholski stated that he will let the dog warden know that it has changed locations.
