The woman was pulled to safety in another room by officers. Discussion regarding the shots fired on Ridgewood. Four young men in a convertible, the passenger fired three rounds into the air. Located car and suspects on Cloverdale. The suspect was arrested and the gun was located, suspect transported to the detention center.
- 5. **Equipment/Vehicles**: Chief Tucholski stated that everything is in good shape. Unit 1 has been having an issue with an O2 sensor. Discussion regarding the tornado sires.
- 6. **General Discussion:** Discussion regarding how to attract candidates to the police department. Chief Tucholski stated that this is a national issue, Mr. Wiech agreed. Lt. Savage stated that department had 24.5 hours at the schools for the month of August; half of a month. Chief Tucholski stated that the department did have some overtime due to staff shortage.
