

Village of Middlefield Recreation Committee Minutes
October 10, 2019

The committee met in regular session. Ms. Arganti called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. with the following members present: Ms. Kaitlyn Arganti, Mr. Sam Morrow and Mayor Garlich.

Also present: Ms. Billie Warren-Recreation Director and Leslie McCoy-Village Administrator.

Registration is open for basketball and wrestling. Will be holding open mats for wrestling and open gyms for basketball. The next Paint n'Sip will be an Ohio shaped wooden board and you can paint whatever you want. Will be handing out water bottles at the Trunk or Treat with information for the recreation department. Discussion regarding the Nature Hike. Discussion regarding the walking class and the lack of interest.
3. **Playground at Marcu Field:** Discussion regarding the other options available by this company. Chief Tucholski did some research and found some equipment and a lower price than what was showed in the proposal. However the equipment was currently on sale. Ms. Warren stated that she made the first cut for the grant. Discussion regarding the budget for this project. Discussion regarding having handicap accessible swings. Discussion regarding the timeline for removing the current equipment.

1. **General Discussion:** Discussion regarding the signage at Eagle Park and if the bathroom issues have been solved. Discussed the house on Johnson Street that has built a ship in the front yard as a Halloween decoration and how much they like it.
