Dear Middlefield Customer,

On May 6th we will become your new waste removal service provider and we could not be more excited to welcome all residents of Middlefield to our 'Major' Family.

Your service day will not change, it will remain Fridays. Our first pickup for you will be on Friday, May 6^{th} .

We do not expect any significant changes from your previous waste removal provider; just some friendly reminders to help provide our best possible service:

- 1. All household waste should be bagged and tied. You may leave your trash in the closed bag or the container we provide you with. This is to help keep the area clean if Mother Nature decides to have a bad day. We will try to keep the area as clean as possible.
- 2. All waste should be piled in the general vicinity of the end of your driveway. We recommend that this be done early in the morning of your collection day to avoid containers being attacked by animals or vermin.
- 3. Due to variances in routes, volumes of material to be picked up and weather, you should make sure that your trash is curbside no later than 6:00 a.m.
- 4. If you need assistance due to a missed pickup please call our office prior to 5pm on your pickup day. Please make sure before calling our offices with a "missed" pickup that you truly were missed. Placing your waste curbside AFTER we have picked up does not warrant a return trip.
- 5. Please make sure that for any large or bulk items, you call and arrange for pickup in advance. We-may not-pick-up without arrangement for additional fees or non-scheduled material. -You-must -schedule bulk-item pickup in advance. Please call our offices at 1-800-366-4921 OR 440-254-4929 to arrange non-standard or bulk-pickup of items. Again, small fees do apply and are to be paid-by -the-owner arranging the pickup. There is NO additional charge for bulk items.

We want our service to be more personable. We are a small, local, family owned and operated business. If using receptacles, they should be placed to the side of the drive, as to not block your vehicle from entering and exiting. The area should be clean after pickup. Customer call representatives are just a phone call away – no holds or automated machines. All of our employees are here to assist you the best they can. PAPER

Magazines, Newspaper, Mail and Copy Paper are accepted.

Paper should be clean and dry. No glossy paper or foil wrapping paper. Paper should not be stained by waste.

CARDBOARD

Must be clean and dry. Should be flattened and emptied of packing materials. No food contamination, such as grease on pizza boxes.

METAL AND ALUMINUM CANS

Only metal or aluminum food and drink cans are accepted. They should be empty, clean and dry prior to placing loosely in recycle bin.

GLASS BOTTLES

All glass bottles should be empty, clean and dry prior to placing loosely in recycle bin. No glassware, mirrors, or light bulbs.

PLASTIC JUGS AND BOTTLES #1 & #2

Only clean and empty plastic bottles and jugs are accepted. Please do not crush bottles and keep lids on. No other plastic items are accepted, even if they have the recycle logo.

RECYCLE RIGHT! – 3 Easy Steps...

1.) When in doubt... THROW IT OUT!

Make sure that all items you are recycling are on your providers list of recyclable items. If the item is not on the list and you are unsure place it in the trash

2.) All Recyclables Must Be Clean and Dry

Food is considered a contaminate. That means no dirty peanut butter jars or water bottles with water still in them. Cardboard should also be clean and dry – no greasy pizza boxes.

3.) No Sorting or Bagging Your Items

Place all approved recycle items into your recycle bin. All items should be loose and unbagged. Bags are also a contaminate to recycle facilities.

OUR RECYCLE PROGRAM IS VERY STRICT; PLEASE MAKE SUREYOUR CONTAINER CONTAINS ONLY PLASTIC NUMBERS 1 + 2; THIS IS ANYTHING WITH A 'NECK + SHOULDERS' (SHAMPOO BOTLES, DETERGENTS, SODA BOTTLES, WATER BOTTLES, ETC.), GLASS, PAPER, ALUMINUM AND CARBOARD. WE DO NOT WANT TO CONTAMINATE OUR LOAD AND WILL LEAVE THE CONTAINER IF IT DOES NOT CONTAIN THE RIGHT ITEMS. ALWAYS FEEL FREE TO EMAIL OR CALL WITH QUESTIONS — WE WANT TO HELP YOU LEARN TO RECYCLE CORRECTLY IN ANY WAY WE CAN.
