How the previous Nina Marcu P.L.A.Y Trust Fund was established. What was the Nina Marcu P.L.A.Y Trust Fund?

The Nina Marcu Private Leisure Assistance for Youth Trust Fund has established to help provide donated money to supplement the cost for youth who are financially unable to participate in leisure activities.

In the year 2000 Steve Marcu and Doug Esenwine started the Nick & Whitey golf outing to raise funds for the Middlefield Youth League in memory of Steve's father; Nick Marcu and Doug's Grandfather; Whitey Esenwine, who had dedicated much of their lives to development and growth of the league. It is rumored that Whitey established the Middlefield youth league! Nick Marcu spent countless hours maintaining the local ball diamonds (located on Sperry Lane), with support from his wife Nina and his very own tractor and drag. He dedicated so much time down at the Mineral Lake ball fields that he became a local icon and the field was named after him. In honor of Nina Marcu's support of her beloved husband's admiration for youth sports the **Nina Marcu P.L.A.Y Trust Fund** was developed, which in 2023 became The Domen / Marcu Foundation.

Steve Marcu and Middlefield Recreation recognize there are a growing number of families whose budgets are stretched so thin that there just isn't room for leisure activities. Though we try to keep the costs of our programs at a minimum, there are still some families who cannot afford them. The Nina Marcu P.L.A.Y Trust Fund, now The Domen /Marcu Foundation, will help defray some of the expenses. However, we do rely on the hearts of the general public, and business community to help support it, either by direct donation or by participating in the annual "Domen / Marcu Foundation" golf outing. Donations are needed on a regular basis to build the fund up so we can continue to provide service to families throughout Cardinal School District.

Domen / Marcu Foundation Policy

Financial assistance through The Domen / Marcu Foundation is for Cardinal School District residents. Families are eligible for ½ off the program fee for programs less than \$50 or a maximum of \$25 for programs more than \$50 (applicants are responsible for any non-resident fees, and any late fees that apply). Participants may receive funds no more than two times per year.

To qualify participants must fill out an application and show proof of one of the following:

- Public Assistance (i.e. Wic Card, ADC Card etc.)
- Proof of being on free or reduced lunch
- Proof of Section 8 Public Housing Assistance

In order for your receipt of financial assistance all programs must meet its minimum registration levels, which are defined internally for every program, before trust fund availability is an option. Financial assistance will be available for most programs, with some exceptions, left to the discretion of the Recreation Director and/or program staff.
