

**Village of Middlefield Recreation Committee Minutes**

The committee met in regular session. Mr. Morrow called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm with the following members present: Mayor Garlich, Mr. Sam Morrow, and Mr. Bill Blue.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of July 10, 2025 were presented for approval. **Mr. Blue made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, motion seconded by Mr. Garlich. Roll Call. All in favor: Yeas (3).**

1. **Fall Youth Sports:** Mr. Soltis stated practices began for all sports this week and a lot of coaches from previous years have returned to volunteer. Mr. Soltis stated uniforms for sports have been ordered and rosters are almost completed. Games will begin in early September.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **Request of Krista Hagans for 50% reimbursement on rental of pavilion for no power at outlets on 7/12/25:** Ms. McCoy stated the cost of the rental was \$100 because she was a nonresident. Ms. McCoy stated there were no calls made to the service department to alert them of the issue and there was no previous renter or renter after her that complained of no power. The committee denied reimbursement for the rental of the pavilion.
2. **Winter Youth Sports:** Ms. McCoy stated registration is not yet open for winter sports, this is just a draft of expenses and revenue from last year so Ms. McCoy recommends keeping the registration fees the same since expenses and revenue were maintained well. Mr. Soltis stated the wrestling community is very good at holding fundraisers to use for singlets, glasses, ear protection, bags, shirts, etc.
3. **General Discussion:** Mr. Klein asked if the volleyball courts at Mineral Lake were going to get some extra attention due to the grass growing in the sand. Mayor Garlich stated he had landscapers come out to look at the parks so he will start working on parks and Village buildings to make them look better. Mayor Garlich stated they have started working on the pickle ball courts.
