The Village of Middlefield's Public Safety Meeting was called to order by roll call at 6:30 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Carl Hornung, Mr. Bill Blue, and Mr. Chris Michalakes.

1. **Personnel:** Chief Tucholski stated Officer Friend is now on his own and is doing very well. Chief Tucholski stated Officer Burge has resigned from his part time position and will now be in the auxiliary position to receive more training. This is an unpaid position. Chief Tucholski stated there is a part time candidate currently going through the ride along process. Lt. Graley stated he worked as a full time Police Officer in Bedford; he lives in Newbury and is looking for a part time position. There are currently 2 full time and 2 part time positions open.
2. **Training:** Chief Tucholski stated CPT training is still being completed by Officers that needs to be done before 2025 ends.
3. **Statistics:** Report is included in the packet. Chief Tucholski stated for the month of October there was 586 total calls for service. Lt. Graley stated thefts are increasing because Walmart now has additional loss prevention employees so these employees specifically focus on thefts and reviewing tape. Lt. Graley stated warrant arrests are up and down, sometimes there are none for months and other times there are more than usual.
4. **Crimes:** Chief Tucholski stated there is nothing unusual. Mr. Morrow stated there is a lot more traffic on Tare Creek. Chief Tucholski stated there is more traffic everywhere. Lt. Graley stated he has sat at Eagle Park running traffic and stated he has yet to pull someone over for speeding on Tare Creek.
5. **Equipment/Vehicles:** Chief Tucholski stated there were two computers that had to be replaced. In 2026 the Ford Explorer will need to be replaced but it will be within budget.
