

**The Village of Middlefield
Public Safety Committee Minutes
March 12, 2026
6:30 PM**

The Village of Middlefield's Public Safety Meeting was called to order by roll call at 6:30 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Carl Hornung, Mr. Bill Blue, Mr. Kyle Kaplan, and Mayor Garlich.

Also present: Ms. Leslie McCoy- Village Administrator, Lt. Graley, Mr. Scott Klein, Ms. Sabine Weizer, and Chief Tucholski.

Chief Tucholski stated Officer Nadaud put in his resignation and will be leaving to go to South Russell on March 16th. Mayor Garlich wanted to recognize Officer Nadaud for his years of service to the Village of Middlefield since he has been with the Middlefield Police Dept for 13 years and discussed doing a formal recognition for him.
2. **Training:** Chief Tucholski stated CPT training has started and there will be a lot of trainings scheduled throughout the summer.
3. **Statistics:** Report is included in the packet.
4. **Crimes:** Chief Tucholski stated there is nothing unusual but there are still thefts happening often at Wal-Mart. Chief Tucholski stated it seems to be the same people stealing on different days.
5. **Equipment/Vehicles:** Chief Tucholski stated the new Tahoe will be equipped in April. Two of the Ford Explorers will be listed for sale as well as the Police Truck.
6. **General Discussion:** Mr. Hornung questioned if the school was going to hire a school resource officer. Chief Tucholski stated there was discussion with the superintendent about possibly hiring an SRO but he has not heard anything further about it.
