This drug drop off box is open to the public 24/7 to safely and anonymously dispose of expired or unused prescription drugs from medicine cabinets in their homes. Prescription drug abuse is a serious problem across the United States and unused medication in the household may contribute to growing rates of prescription drug abuse among Americans, particularly teenagers. Among teenagers, prescription drugs are the drug of choice due to their ease of access and the belief they are less harmful than street drugs.
